# Academic Schedule 2009- 2010 Hawai'i Pacific University

Hawai'i Pacific University provides a traditional semester system with 15-week fall and spring semesters. In addition, the University offers winter and summer sessions.

The academic year (nine months) refers to the fall and spring semesters (September - May).

International students are required by U.S. Immigration to be full-time students during the fall and spring semesters. Full-time status for an undergraduate student is 12 credits and for a graduate student, 9 graduate level credits. However, it is common for full-time undergraduate students to take five courses and for graduate students to take four courses per semester.

The tuition for winter and summer sessions is determined on a per-class basis. Winter and summer sessions are optional for all students.
